

# Kicking Horse Mountain Resort

Kicking Horse Mountain Resort is the first new four-season resort to open in the Canadian Rockies in 25 years. The area is the exalted meeting place of the Rockies, the Purcells and the Selkirks, three of the continent's most majestic ranges and six National Parks surround the Resort – Banff, Glacier, Kootenay, Yoho, Mt. Revelstoke and Jasper.

The proposed mountain village and master planned community includes 3,000 bed units - a mix of townhouses, single family residences, condominium lodges, hotels and B&Bs as well as a multitude of shops, bars, restaurants and other commercial amenities that suit a four-season alpine resort.

'Kicking Horse Mountain Resort' is named after the renowned river and the high-alpine pass that were key to the opening of the Canadian West, and as such, the name evokes a sense of discovery, exploration and history.'

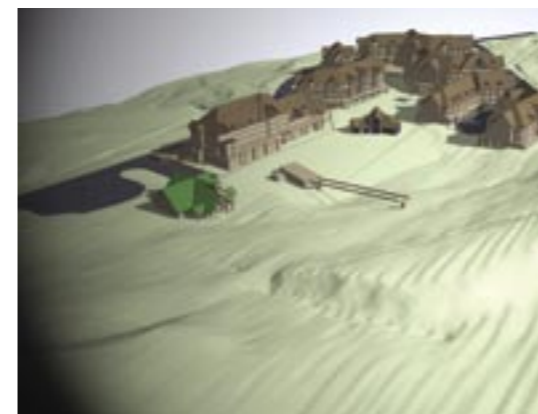
The village and plaza draws upon the rugged nature of the Rockies and utilizes natural features including water, rock outcroppings, large boulders and natural planting.

Tom Barratt Ltd. is working on overall planning and detailed village & plaza design.

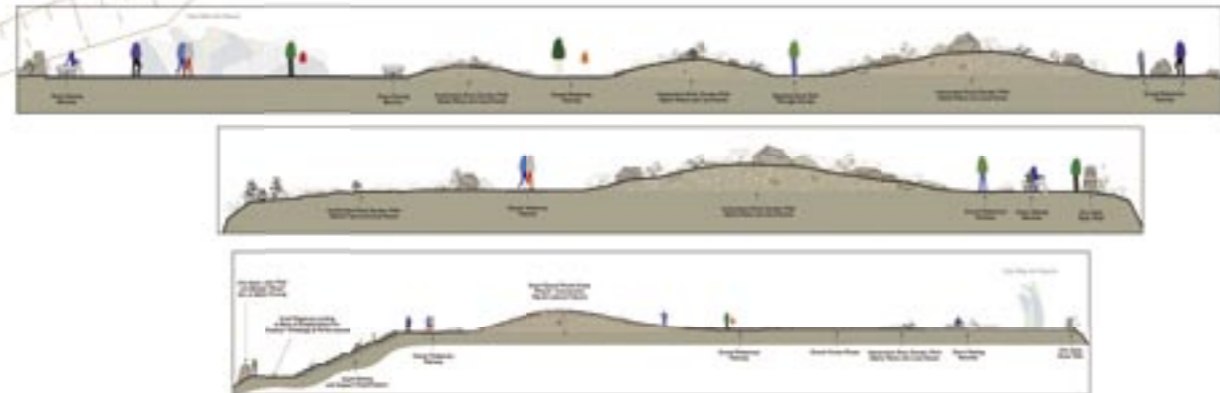


- ↑↑ Site Section of Plaza.
